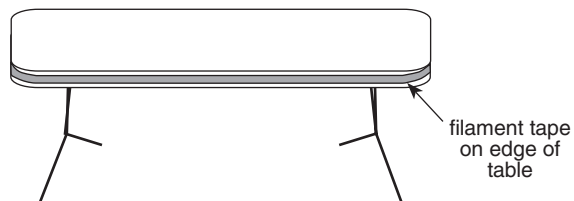
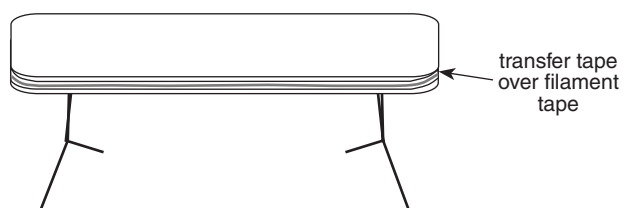


HOW TO DECORATE A TABLE WITH A TABLECOVER, LIGHTS AND GOSSAMER:

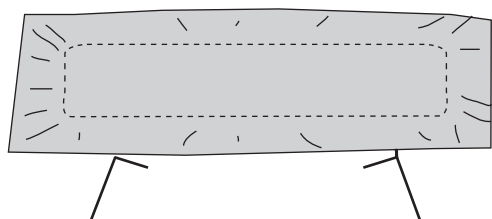
- Place filament tape along the top outside edge of a table.



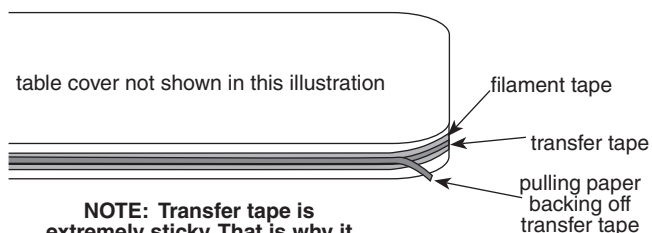
- Place transfer tape over the filament tape. **DO NOT** remove the paper backing yet.



- Drape and center the plastic tablecover over the table top.



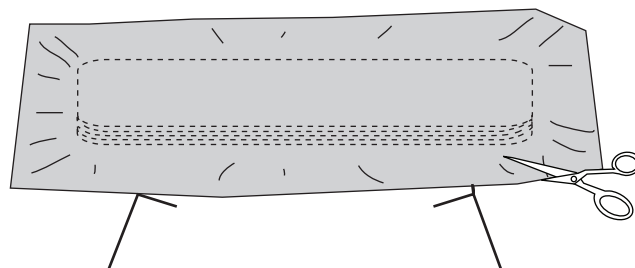
- With help and starting at one end, carefully remove the paper backing and adhere the tablecover to the transfer tape, while a second person is gently pulling on the opposite end of the tablecover so that it will be smooth.



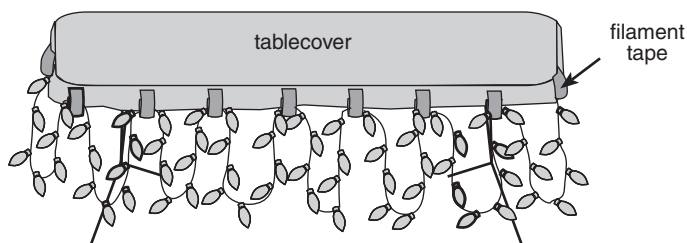
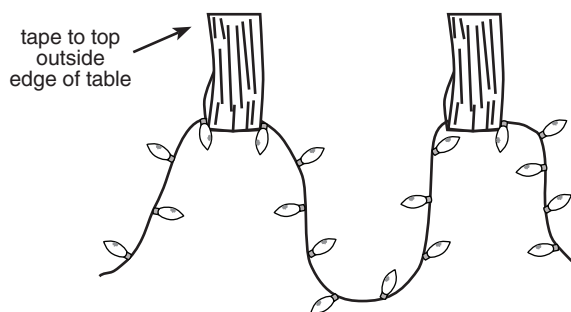
NOTE: Transfer tape is extremely sticky. That is why it is best to place filament tape along the outside edge of the table and then place transfer tape on top of it. It makes clean-up so much easier when you pull off the filament tape and the transfer tape comes with it!

- Once the ends are secured, **repeat** this process from front to back.

- Use a scissors to trim the excess tablecover below the transfer tape.



- Swag the string of lights around the front and sides of the table and secure by making loops of filament tape over table cover as shown.



- Fold the width of the gossamer in half, but do not cut off the length.

- Using a hand stapler, pleat the folded edge of the gossamer every 4".

- Place transfer tape along the outside edge of the table, over the filament tape pieces.

- Position the stapled edge of the gossamer over the transfer tape until as much of the table as desired is covered (the lights will now be behind the gossamer).

- If a trim is desired to cover the top edge of the gossamer, apply another layer of transfer tape, and then secure the trim to it.

- This completes the instructions for decorating a table.
